Conditions of Entry

1. You must complete an online entry through Global Entries Online (www.globalentriesonline.com.au<<http://www.globalentriesonline.com.au>>) acknowledging an understanding and acceptance of all Conditions of Entry to this event. Your Global Entries Online registration must include all details about yourself and your horse. Please do not fail to complete any information you have especially your EWA registration number, your horse's EWA registration number and your email address and phone number.
2. Please ensure you are familiar with the Equestrian WA Codes of Conduct. Please refer to the EWA website for more information www.equestrianwa.org.au<<http://www.equestrianwa.org.au/><<http://www.equestrianwa.org.au/%3chttp://www.equestrianwa.org.au/>>>
3. Entries open to all competitors on Global Entries online at 8am 3 October 2016. Closing Date for Entries: All entries must be received by **8pm 21 October 2015 or when the draw is full**, whichever is sooner for each class. Event organisers reserve the right to fill any vacant spots / scratchings following the close of entries.



- 4. Refunds and Scratching:** No refund will be given for scratching once entries have closed (should your spot be replaced by a full paying waitlist rider the Organising Committee will consider refunding up to 80% of your entry fee). Entries withdrawn before close of entries will receive a refund of 80% of their entry fee paid. If your entry is refused or rejected by the Organising Committee a full refund will be provided. **All refunds will be completed after the event.**

Should you wish to scratch please contact Hayley Hickson on 0439489988 or hayley@eventinginthepark.com.au - **do not process in in Global Entries yourself.** This is to ensure our waitlist riders can be promoted to a spot in the draw correctly.

- 5. Waitlist:** Should classes be oversubscribed prior to the close of entries, Competitors are able to register their interest to enter via the waitlist class options. A \$100.00 deposit is required to enter the waitlist and should you not receive a spot in the competition this will be refunded in full.
- 6. Acceptance of Entry:** Please note the Organising committee reserves the right to refuse, reject and / or interchange entries at any time, this includes full paid completed entries and waitlist entries. Should the organising committee reject your entry, you will receive a full refund of your entry fee paid to date.
- 7. Body Protectors** are compulsory for this competition.
- 8. Back Numbers:** when completing any of the sections of this event, riders and horses must have their allocated back number on. Eventing bibs must be worn by the rider and bridle and / or saddlecloth numbers must be worn by horses at all times.
- 9. Prize Ceremonies & Prizes:** A prize ceremony will be conducted at the completion of all classes on the day. Riders **MUST** be mounted for presentations.
- 10. Draw:** The draw will be completed as a live lotto draw held on Friday 28 October 2016. Further details will be provided closer to the date.

Once completed the Draw will be available on www.globalentriesonline.com.au<<http://www.globalentriesonline.com.au>> from Friday 11 November 2016. You **MUST** ride in your draw order in each section. Riders may not move in the draw without the written permission of



the Event Organiser. Organisers retain the right to change the draw if necessary.

It is the riders responsibility to monitor the running of the competition and ensure they are ready on time, if you do not present to the marshall when required you will forfeit your entry and no refund will be provided.

Multiple rides will not be placed first and last in the class. A minimum of 10 riders will be placed between any multiple rides that are drawn out close together in the lottery process.

11. **Rider Attire:** EITP Shirt / Cross Country Colours or Sponsor provided attire

12. **Horse Attire:** All horses/ponies must be plaited for all sections of the event.

13. **Eligibility for Competition:**

Rider: To be eligible to enter the rider must be either a full financial member or associate member of the EWA. Membership documents must be available on request. Riders must be at least 13 years of age to compete.

Horses: All horses need to be EWA registered to enter.

Qualifications:

Diamond Class: For a Horse and Rider to start in the Diamond Class, they must have a minimum of:

- One (1) MER qualifying result in official EvA105 or A Grade (or Championship) Pony Club Competition; or
- Two (2) 1.10m Show Jumping rounds at a registered Equestrian Australian Event with a result of ≤ 16 jumping penalties, One (1) with a result of ≤ 4 penalties.

A rider, who is established at a level, by achieving one MER at the level, allows a rider to compete at that level on any horse that is qualified to compete at that level.

Horse and Rider combinations who have one (1) MER qualifying result at CNC**/CIC**/CCN**/CCI** or have completed two (2) 1.25m Show Jumping rounds or higher at a registered Equestrian Australian Event **are not** permitted to enter the Diamond Class.

Diamond class qualifications must be completed between 1 January 2016 and 21 October 2016.



Qualifications at a higher level achieved after 21 October 2016 and prior to the commencement of the event will automatically remove the rider from the Diamond Class. If there is space in the Grand Prix the combination may be moved up into this class but will be responsible for paying the additional \$150 in entry fee. This will only be done in consultation with the rider.

Grand Prix: For a Horse and Rider to start in the Grand Prix, they must have a minimum of:

- Three (3) MER qualifying results in any of the following CNC*, CIC*, CCN* or CCI* or higher. One of these may not have more the 20 cross country jumping faults. The other two must be clear of cross country faults.
- Two (2) x 1.20m Show Jumping round or higher at a registered Equestrian Australian Event with a result of ≤ 16 jumping penalties, One (1) with a result of ≤ 4 penalties.

A rider, who is established at a level, by achieving one MER at the level, allows a rider to compete at that level on any horse that is qualified to compete at that level.

Grand Prix qualifications may be completed between 1 March 2015 and 21 October 2016.

Qualification information **must** be included in your global entries online registration.

Horses may only enter one class at this event.

One rider may only ride a **MAXIMUM of 2 horses in each class**

14. **EWA Registration Documents** of Riders and horses' proof of age must be available on the day of competition.
15. **Catering:** Food and refreshments will be available for purchase on the day from variety of sources. Please refer to www.eventinginthepark.com.au for full details.
16. **Venue Entry:** As per entry details above Competitors will be provided with 1 x Kirin Riders Lounge ticket for the rider and 1 x Groom Pass (which will include access to the McInerney Ford Lounge). No other access will be provided as part of Entry.



17. **Yards:** There will not be any yards made available at this event, all riders will be required to bring their own and ensure the materials used are compliant with EA Rules.
18. **Disclaimer of Liability:** Neither the Organising Committee, nor the State Equestrian Centre, nor Equestrian Western Australia nor the Town of Victoria Park, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, grooms, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
19. **Swabbing:** Random swabbing may take place and will be in accordance with EA/FEI Veterinary Regulations.
20. The competition is run in accordance with the Equestrian Australia **Hot Weather Policy**. Access to water and appropriate cooling equipment will be provided in accordance with this policy and vets will be on course during the day.
21. Riders or owners who have an **existing debt** with Eventing WA Promotions or Equestrian Western Australia may not be permitted to enter a horse or compete in this event. Please ensure all outstanding debts are cleared before entering. If you have previously nominated to complete a helper duty but not completed it you will not be given preference on reserve lists or draws.
22. **Protests and Appeals:** These must be in writing and accompanied by a fee of \$100 within 20 minutes of scores being posted.
23. **Warm up etiquette:** There is no lungeing in the warm up arena. If you wish to lunge your horse you must do so away from the main arena so as not to interfere with other competitors.
24. **Officials, Ground Staff and Volunteers:** These people are essential in the running of our competitions and events. Please treat them with respect. Poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated. Verbal or physical bullying behaviour will be reported to the CEO of EWA and disciplinary action will be taken where appropriate.
25. **Duty of care:** It is your responsibility to promptly report unsafe and or hazardous situations to the Event Organiser.



26. **Stallion Code of Conduct:** see the EA guidelines.
27. **Cleanliness:** ALL riders, supporters and owners will be required to ensure the leave these grounds as they found them. This is vitally important for the success of this event.
28. **Manure:** All horse manure will be required to be removed before leaving the grounds. Please ensure you bring suitable equipment to do this.
29. **No Dogs Allowed.**
30. **Parking:** Floats Recommended. Due to limited space, Goosenecks and Trucks will ONLY be permitted entry to the event if they are carrying two or more horses.
Competitors will be required to pay a **\$100 bond** for a Parking Permit which will provide access to the car park. When ready to leave your site will be inspected by our parking attendant who will sign your Parking Permit stating that the site is in a suitable condition and you can exchange your parking permit for a refund of your bond at the nominated vendor site. Sand (inc. wheelbarrow and shovel) will be provided to assist with top dressing the car parking sites, should any divots / holes etc. need filling.
31. The Event Organisers **reserve the right to alter or amend the program and competitions offered.** Event Organisers reserve the right to amend the conditions of entry, as well as refuse, reject and / or interchange entries. Entrants who do not adhere to the EWA Code of Conduct will find entries will not be accepted or they will be eliminated. In the event that there are low entries in any class the organising committee reserves the right to amalgamate or amend classes where necessary.
